

REQUEST FOR QUALIFICATIONS

The Lesotho National Federation of Organisations of the Disabled (LNFOD) is seeking quotations from the qualified legal practitioners practising as advocates in the courts of Lesotho to represent and present the case of people with disabilities in the Constitutional Court of Lesotho in March 2017. LNFOD is asking the interested legal practitioner to include in his or her legal fees, all the charges that shall be needed for the duration of the case as LNFOD shall not be able to effect payments after 2017. The legal practitioner so wishing to submit his or her quotation must have the track record of constitutional and human rights litigation in or outside Lesotho.

OBJECTIVES OF THE REPRESENTATION

To litigate, protect and enforce the **constitutional rights to freedom from discrimination, equality and equal treatment** for and on behalf of people with disabilities in the Constitutional Court of Lesotho

To provide legal advice and counselling to people with disabilities (clients) in relation with the case

DELIVERABLES

The legal practitioner is required to provide brief plan as to how she or he will conduct the case including consultations with clients, court appearances and all the incidentals of the case and the costs of such thereof.
